Mims (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Naties L. Mims, Guardian for H. J. Jesse M. H. Callaway and Harvey B. Mims, one-half interest in all that piece of parcel or lot of land situate in the City and County of Greenville, State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds; to wit: beginning at a point on South side of Union Street, and running thence N. 34° W. 98 feet to a stake corner, thence S. 32° W. 1840 feet to a stake corner, thence S. 49° E. 60 feet to a stake corner, thence N. 29° E. 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake corner, thence N. 52° E. 95 feet to beginning corner, containing $26/100$ of an acre, more or less, and being a part of the estate of Danielia Dickson, deceased.

Callaway and Harvey B. Mims and their Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
