KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Henry G. Markley, of The County of Greenville,

in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand and four Hundred (\$7,500.00) Dollars, to myself in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by L. Huguenot Mills, of the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Huguenot Mills and its successors and assigns, all that certain piece, part and lot of land, situate lying and being in the City and County of Greenville in the state aforesaid, on the corner of Broad and Jackson streets, and having the following lines, angles and bounded to wit; beginning on an iron pin in the corner of Broad and Jackson streets and running thence, S. 17° 30' W. Two Hundred and twenty two feet (222) to an iron pin in the North side of an alley twelve feet wide; thence along the North side of said alley S. 70° 16' E. One Hundred and seventy seven feet and ten inches (177-10) to an iron pin in the North side of said alley; thence N. 17° 30' E. One Hundred and twelve feet (112) to an iron pin; thence S. 72° 30' E. sixty eight feet and ten inches (68-10) to an iron pin in the West side of an alley ten feet wide; thence, along the West side of said last named alley, N. 17° 30' E. One Hundred sixteen feet to an iron pin in the South side of Broad street; thence, N. 72° 30' W. along the South side of Broad street, Two hundred and forty six feet and six inches (246-6) to the point of Beginning.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Huguenot Mills, its successors, Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Huguenot Mills, its successors,

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
