(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. McElroy all that certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County and state aforesaid, containing eighty-six acres more or less, bounded by lands of Boswell, Mrs. Nease, T. Kelley, et al with following lines: beginning at point on the road, thence S 89° E 19.20 to a stone corner, thence S 24° E 4.40 to a stone, thence S 87° E 31.20 to a stone, thence N 18° E 10.85 to a dogwood, thence N 85° E 33.50 to a stone at mouth of branch; thence following branch to a wild cherry, thence N 09° E 14.12 to stake near road thence following road to the beginning, being tract of land conveyed to me by John L. Bailey Probate Judge for said County on November 5, 1900, the deed being recorded in the R. M. office for said County in Book 3494, page 81.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W. McElroy his
