KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. Joseph Edwards of the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, and Perry Edwards and William S. Edwards, in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars, to be in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. Joseph Edwards, have given,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Joseph Edwards and William S. Edwards all that piece, parcel or tract of land located on Mountain Creek waters of Sherrill river in the County of Greenville and state aforesaid, more particular described by the following metes and bounds; beginning on a maple on Mountain Creek at the mouth of a spring branch and running thence with said spring branch $\frac{1}{2} \text{ N } 62^{\circ} 26' 6.30$ to a white oak 3 x om. thence $\frac{3}{4} \text{ S } 36^{\circ} 21' 9.91$ to a post oak, thence $\frac{1}{2} \text{ S } 47^{\circ} 21' 18.30$ chains to a light wood stake, thence down the meanderings of Mountain Creek to a red oak down, thence $\frac{1}{2} \text{ S } 36^{\circ} 21' 25$ chains to a stone, thence $\frac{1}{2} \text{ N } 56^{\circ} 38.00$ chains to a stake 3 x near Mountain Creek, thence $\frac{1}{2} \text{ N } 39^{\circ} 21' 11.62$ chains to a pine down, thence $\frac{1}{2} \text{ N } 61^{\circ} 21' 6.20$ chains to a pine 3 x om, thence $\frac{1}{2} \text{ S } 43^{\circ} 15.70$ chains to hickory 3 x om, thence $\frac{1}{2} \text{ S } 33.30$ to a sassafrass on bank of Mountain Creek, thence up the meandering of Mountain Creek to the beginning corner containing eighty-four and three fourths acres more or less, and known as the Mill tract bounded by lands of Perry Edwards, John Taylor and others,

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Perry Edwards & Wm. S. Edwards, their Heirs and Assigns forever to be shared by them equally. Said Perry & Wm. S. Edwards are to share equally in the ownership and possession of the said tract of land and its appurtenances, each having an undivided interest. And I do hereby bind my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Perry Edwards and William S. Edwards, their Heirs and Assigns, against me and my person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Heirs, and against every
