Williams

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Clauson J. Williams, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain piece or lot of land, situate in the State and County aforesaid, City of Greenville, West of Augusta street, beginning on a forty-foot street at the corner of R.J. Williams' line running through N. 3<sup>rd</sup> & W. 17<sup>th</sup> feet to line of Q, 2M, 2M, 3C, thence with the said line N. 87<sup>1/2</sup> & W. 39<sup>1/2</sup> feet to a thirty-foot street in rear of said lots, thence 216 feet along the said thirty-foot street to an iron fence, thence N. 86<sup>1/2</sup> & E. 40<sup>1/2</sup> feet to the beginning former, being known as Lots Nos. 8, 10, 13 and 14, of survey of J. M. Southern, made the 5<sup>th</sup> of March, 1898, #8 containing 43 100/100 of acre, more or less, #10, 40 100/100 of acre, more or less, #13, 44 100/100 of acre, more or less, and #14, 50 100/100 of acre, piece or less bounded by lands of R.J. Heirs and Assigns, against myself as Executor and H.P. Hannett, Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
