sell and release unto the said A. H. H. Williams Pres. A. L. Auburn Vice Pres. M. Brown  
Secy. H. P. Johnson Treasurer and their successors in office a  
certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being  
in Austin Township Greenville County and state aforesaid  
on branch of Bridge Fork Creek, branch waters of Saluda river  
beginning at stone bearing corner in road 3x thence N. 41° E.  
4.80 to a stone in "gully" 3x; thence up the meanders of  
said "gully" S. 35° E. to a stone in said "gully" to crossing of  
old line 3x. thence S. 57° E. 0.38 links to a stone 3x. thence E. N. 58°  
S. 7.80 to the beginning stone. Containing one and three quarters  
(1 3/4) acres be the same more or less.
