KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That L. O. Patterson

of the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of four thousand and no/100 Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. R. Ware, H. K. Loomis, F. S. Dargann, of Said City County, State

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. R. Ware, H. K. Loomis, and F. S. Dargann, in equal shares, a three fourths undivided interest in and to all those two certain pieces, parcels or tracts of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, a short distance south east of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, between the Augusta Road and the Piedmont Road (formerly known as the Wilsons Bridge or Wilson Ferry Road) known tracts numbered three (3) and four (4) of the lands of James Birnie, deceased, said two tracts containing thirty three (33) acres more or less, in the aggregate, and having the following limits and bounds, according to a plat thereof prepared by St. Sauntern, and bearing date the 21st day of April, A.D. 1843, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin 3x11/2 in on the South side of the Augusta Road, on the corner of tract No. 2, of the Birnie lands, (now belonging to Mrs. Mary B. Lewis) and running thence N. 46 3/4 W. along said Augusta Road, 5.55 chains, to a stake 3x0 in in ditch, at corner of O. O. Mills land; thence following line of O. O. Mills, S. 75 1/2 W. 11.70 chains to a stake 3x0 in in ditch; thence S. 17 1/2 W. along the Piedmont or Wilsons Bridge Road 7.50 ch. to a stake 3x0 in; thence along said road S. 26 1/2 W. 14.96 ch. to a stake 3x0 in on corner of R. N. Darlis land; thence following said Darlis line S. 46 1/4 E. 13.52 ch. to a stake or iron pin 3x11/2 in on corner of tract No. 2, belonging to Mrs. Lewis, N. 26 1/2 E. 32.60 chains to the beginning corner; these being the same two tracts of land conveyed to me the said L. O. Patterson, by Mrs. Mary B. Lewis, and Mrs. Ada M. Cowart, respectively by two deeds, bearing date July 24, 1905 and not yet

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto said J. R. Ware, H. K. Loomis, and F. S. Dargann, Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J. R. Ware, H. K. Loomis, and F. S. Dargann, and their Heirs and Assigns, against myself and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
