 Five (\$475.00) Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
 Frank J. Dargan, of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina,
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
 sell and release unto the said Frank J. Dargan, his
 interest in and to, hereby reserving unto myself my heirs and
 assigns the remaining three fourths (3/4) interest in all that piece, parcel
 or tract of land situate lying and being in the County of
 Greenville in the State of South Carolina, near the corporate limits
 of the City of Greenville. Beginning at a Stone 3x corner of lands
 of George B. Thurston and running thence N. 48° E. 18.00 to a Stone 3x;
 thence S. 42° W. 1.9.70 to a Stone 3x in the Valley Bridge or former
 road; thence into said road S. 62 1/2 W. 3.65; thence S. 47 1/2 W. 2.00; thence
 S. 37 1/2 W. 4.30; thence across Brushy Creek, to a Post Oak 3x; thence
 S. 45° E. 1.17.5 to a Stake 3x; thence S. 10° E. 6.10 to the beginning corner
 containing Thirty (30) acres more or less, full having such
 shape form and boundaries as represented by plat hereof made
 by J. A. Southern & S. dated November 26th 1892, being the same

And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Frank J. Dargan.

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
