 in the State aforesaid, ... of Plaintiff, and one dollar in consideration of the sum of love and affection for my  
 grand daughter, Marie Thompson, and one dollar, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
 the said Plaintiff, I, Marcella Thompson,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
 sell and release unto the said Marie A. Thompson all my right, title and interest  
 in all that lot or parcel of land situate lying and being in the  
 City of Greenville in the County of Greenville in the state aforesaid  
 being the same lot conveyed to me by my wife, Jane Donaldson  
 now deceased, and on which the said Jane Donaldson lived  
 at the time of her death, my interest in said land being as  
 an heir at law and distributor of the estate of my said  
 deceased wife, Jane Donaldson, and being a part of the lot  
 conveyed to me by Alexander McBee by his deed dated 4, April  
 1884, and being all of said lot so conveyed to me except a small  
 part thereof conveyed by me to Garrison Kilbanks before the  
 execution of the aforesaid deed by me to my said deceased

 and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Marcella Thompson.

 person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
