Thence S. 47 1/2 W. 37 1/2 feet to iron pin at corner of said lot #4 1/3, thence S. 30° W. 101 feet to the beginning corner on Pendleton street, being all of lot #4 of land made by J. M. Burton, and recorded in book A. of plats, page 148 and so much of lot #5 as is covered by the above specifications.
