Beginning at an iron spike in the middle of Miller street, between Burnette's corner, and runs with his line N. 73° W. 206 feet to a stone, corner of W. P. Moore's lot, thence N. 11° E. 274 feet to an iron spike in the middle of Grace street, John Miller's line, thence with his line S. 82° E. 206 feet to iron spike in the middle of Grace street at intersection of Miller street, thence with Miller street S. 16° W. 307 feet to beginning corner and containing One and $\frac{1}{8}$ acres bounded by lots of Rev. Burnette, John Miller, and Dr. Johnson.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said A. D. Howell his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said A. D. Howell his Heirs and Assigns forever.

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
