 D. A. Liseberger of the County and state aforesaid
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
 sell and release unto the said D. A. Liseberger all that certain tract of land and lot
 of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville
 in the State aforesaid on Prince street, and having the following
 lines, metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning on a stake on Prince
 street in the line dividing the lot herein conveyed from lot
 purchased by me from estate of T. L. Dower, deceased and running
 thence with the line of last mentioned lot, S. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ W., two hundred
 and seventeen and one half feet to a stake; thence S. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$
 E., sixty six feet and eight inches to a stake; thence N. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$
 E., two hundred and seventeen and one half feet to a stake
 in the line of Prince street on south side; thence with the
 line of Prince street N. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ W., 66 feet and 8 inches to the
 porch of beginning, containing by estimation 14,500 square
 feet above low level, and being part of lot conveyed to me
 by Thos. L. Dower and Whiting Syburn, Trustees by deed
