(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
sell and release unto the said W. L. Ford all that tract or parcel of land in the
Eash side of the Gatesville and Adams Mill road Beginning at
a stump near said house (corner of Baker and Ford) and
running thence N. 57° 45' E. 58 to stone x (new corner); thence N. 46° 30'
W. 10. 30 ch. to stone x (new corner); thence N. 20° 00' W. 0. 03 chs. to stone x
(new corner); thence N. 42° 30' W. 4. 13 ch to middle of Gatesville and
Adams Mill road opposite stone x (new corner), on each side of
said road 23 links back on line; thence with the middle of
