Smith of the City and County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. T. H. Smith all that piece of land or lot of land known as Lots #1 (one) and #2 (two) situated on the S. E. corner of Hampton Avenue and Frank Street in the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid and having of the following lines and boundaries, to wit: Beginning at the S. E. corner of Hampton Avenue and Frank Street; thence S. 32° 40' E. One Hundred and twenty-three (23) feet with Hampton Avenue to a stake (corner lot #3); thence N. 57° 35' E. One Hundred and Fifty (150) feet to a stake in line of lot #12; thence with line of last mentioned lot N. 32° 40' E. One Hundred and Twenty-four and One-Half (124 1/2) feet to stake in Frank Street; thence with Frank Street S. 57° E. One Hundred and fifty (150) feet to the Beginning corner, containing 1860 1/2 square feet, more or less, Reference being had to a certain plan recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County Volume 444, page 838, the above description will more fully define the same being map of J. T. H. Bryan's property surveyed and subdivided by J. D. Eastley March 1, 1905.)
