Durrance, all that piece of land situate lying and being on the Rutherford Road and on South side of South Tyger River, thirteen miles from Greenville S.C. containing One Hundred and Thirteen and  $\frac{1}{4}$  acres more or less, and hath such marked bounds &c as follows: Beginning on a water Oak on South Tyger River; thence up the River; thence 8.50 to a stake on ridge; thence with the meanders of said River to a stone at the mouth of a spring branch thence up same to a stone; thence North  $\frac{1}{4}$  E.  $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 7.10 to a stone N. W. W.
