parcel of land situate lying and being in Saluda-  
Township in Greenville County and the State  
aforesaid. Beginning on a fence 3 x runs thence S. 72° E.  
1/3. 10 to stone 3 x. thence S. 78° W. 5. 20 ch. to stone 3 x. thence  
N. 20. 50 to stone 3 x in ridge road to 3 x of track No. 1. thence  
S. 18. 60 to the beginning fence 3 x. and containing eleven  
and three fourths acres, and is part of the tract of  
land of Robert Pitman late of the County deceased  
and founded on the 1<sup>st</sup> by Mary J. Jewell (track one)  
Mary Pitman on the S. 2<sup>nd</sup>. Pitman on the West
