In trust to sell and dispose of the said property on such terms as to the said J.C. Duane may seem best, and on such sale to make good fee simple deed to the purchaser, and in trust to collect in the proceeds of sale and after payment of all expenses incident to said sale, to divide the balance among the grantors herein, in the proportions directed by the laws of the state of South-Carolina, that is unto Sarah E. Jolly one-third hereof, and unto all of the other grantors herein one-seventh of the remaining two-thirds.

AND until such sale in trust to rent out the said premises to pay all taxes and other expenses which may be incident to caring for said property and to charge the same against proceeds of sale.
