Sirrine, Civil Engineer, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, in Plat Book A. page 122-123, the said lot of land being designated as lots Nos. 1 and 2, in Block B, as shown on said plat and having the following metes and bounds to wit Beginning at a point on the West side of Sumner Street, and running; thence N. 15 degrees and 15 minutes E. 189 feet and 9-2 inches to the corner of said Sumner and Garlington Streets, and; thence with the said Garlington Street N. 72 degrees 85 minutes W. 100 feet; thence S. 15 degrees and 15 minutes W. 192 feet and 11 inches; thence 100 feet to the beginning. TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
