WHEREAS, I, Alice Caldwell (formerly Alice Ingle) of the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, Am the mother of Leona Caldwell, a female child of the age of four (4) years, and Whereas the Father (Noah Caldwell) of the said child, my former husband has been separated from me since December, 1909 and his whereabouts is unknown.

And whereas it is my desire to bind or dispose of the custody and tuition of my said daughter (Leona Caldwell) until she reaches the age of twenty-one (21) years, unto the said P.D. Lavender who is a competent and suitable person in every way to take care of and support said child..

NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, the said Alice Caldwell in consideration of the foregoing premises, and the further consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by P.D. Lavender of the County of Greenville and in the State of South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, released, disposed and conveyed of the custody, and do hereby grant, release, dispose and convey of the custody and tuition of the said Leona Caldwell unto the said P.D. Lavender his heirs for and during the whole of such time as the said Leona Caldwell shall remain under the age of twenty-one (21) years, and the possession of the said Leona Caldwell to the said P.D. Lavender his heirs is hereby conveyed.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAID LEONA CALDWELL for such time as aforesaid unto the said P.D. Lavender and his heirs.

Provided that the said P.D. Lavender and his heirs shall at all times during the time aforesaid provide for the said Leona Caldwell in sickness and in health, and at all times to supply her with suitable food and clothing, and shall also cause the said Leona Caldwell within such time to read and write, and give to her such further education and advantages as the said P.D. Lavender may feel to do so.
