

- of land situate on the West side of Rutherford Street, in the First Ward of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina; which lots have since said date been occupied and used for Church purposes by an unorganized mission of the Protestant Episcopal Church, known as "Saint James's Mission";

AND WHEREAS it is now proposed that the said Saint James's Mission shall become incorporated under the laws of said State and shall become an organized mission of said Protestant Episcopal Church, and shall finish paying for said land and hold the same in its corporate name;

NOW, Therefore, be it resolved by the Vestry of Christ Church, Greenville, S.C. that when the said Saint James's Mission becomes incorporated and pays to the Treasurer of this Vestry all such sums as may have been heretofore advanced by this Vestry for the purchase of said land, with interest, a deed do forthwith issue in the name of this Vestry, conveying the said lands to the said Saint James's Mission.

We, A.R. Mitchell, Rector of Christ Church, Greenville, S.C. and S.S. Crittenden, Secretary of the Vestry of said Christ Church do hereby certify unto all whom it may concern that the foregoing is a true and correct copy of a resolution duly adopted at a meeting of said Vestry, held at Greenville, South Carolina on the nineteenth day of February A.D. 1909, at which meeting a majority of said Vestry were present in person; while all of said Vestry had notice of such meeting.

We further certify that said resolution was adopted by vote of a majority of the whole number of persons composing said Vestry; and that the said A.R. Mitchell, presided at said meeting.
