NOW, THE REPORE, THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, That the said Samuel A. Townes as Commissioner of the said Court under, and by virtue of, the said Decree, and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred and thirty one Dollars paid him by the said John L. Williams the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents doth Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said John L. Williams, his heirs and assigns, all that tract and parcel of land, lying and being situate in the State and District aforesaid near waters of Saluda River, containing Three hundred and sixty-four acres, said land being bounded by lands of Robt. Holliday, Austin Williams, Thomas Kelly, Allen McDavid, John B. Williams and Henry T. Stokes.

Together with all and singular the Hereditaments, Rights, Members and Appurtenances whatsoever, to the said land belonging, or in anywise appertaining; and the Reversions and Remainders, Rents, Issues and Profits thereof; and also all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest, Dower, Possession, Property, Benefit, Claim, and Demand whatsoever, both at Lew and in Equity, of the Heirs and Representatives of the AAA John Williams, deceased and of the parties to this suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof, by, from, or under them, or either of them, to have and to hold the said land with its Hereditaments, Privileges and Appurtenences unto the said John L. Williams, his Heirs and Assigns, to his and their only proper use, benefit, and behoof forever.
