said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or apportaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, and its successors and assigns forever, subject to the conditions above set forth.

And the said grantor hereof does hereby agree to release and discharge and to indemnify and save harmless the grantee hereof, its successors and assigns from and against any and all claims which may arise as the result from fire caused by the grantee or its employees or otherwise and the grantor further agrees that any insurance which it may take out upon buildings along and adjacent to this strip, or contents thereof and on any and all property of every kind whatsoever connected therewith, shall be so taken out as to make the insurance Company the party liable for losses by fire, Policies of Insurance to contain provision to the effect that for any such loss the Insurance Company is to have no right of subrogation against the grantee, the Failway Company herein.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the grantee hereinabove named and its successors and assigns, against itself and its successors lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
