Presbyteries; (2) To make an annual report for information to the Synod of South Carolina, in connection with the Presbyterian Church in the United States at each regular meeting of said Synod: (3) To make a report for information to each of the Presbyteries owning the said College at the regular spring and Fall meetings of the said Presbyteries. The report to said Presbyteries at their Fall meetings shall include the following points, to wit; (a) A statement of the assets and liabilities of the said college; (b) A statement of such other matters as in the judgement of the Board of the Trustees may be desireable and proper. Fifth The names and residences of all managers, Trustees, Derectors or other officers are as follows: C.E. Grehem, President of Board, Rev S.C. Byrd President of College, Rev. E.F. Davis Secretary of Board; J.E. Hagood Vice-President of Board. Sixth that they desired to be incorporated in pupetuity.

Now therefore, I.J. Gentt, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested, by Chapter XLVIII., Article II., Code of 1902, and Acts amenditory thereto, do hereby declare the said organization to be a body politic and corporate, with all the rights, powers; privileges and immunities, and subject to all the limitations and liabilities, conferred by said Chapter, XLVIII., Article II., Code of 1902, and Acts amenditory thereto. Given under my head and the seat of the State, at Columbia, this 30th, day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and six, and in the one hundred and thirtieth year of the Inder meence of the United States of America.
