And the said Lessee, for and in consideration of the above letten premises, doth covenant and agree to pay to the said bessor, the above stipulated rent, in the manner herein required. And it is further agreed, that unless one month's notice, in writting, be given, previous to the expirat ion to the period herein specified by the lessor to the lessee, of her desire to have possission of the premises, or to change the conditions of the lease after such expiration; or the like notice be given by the lessee to the lessor, of his intention to vacate the premises of ter such expiration; then it is hereby agreed that this lease will be considered as extending and binding in all its provisions for one year after such expiration and so to continue from year to year, until such notice be given by either party, previous to the expiration of such extended te rm. But the destruction of the premises by fire, or by eny other casualty, shall trminate t his agreement.
