And Whereas, in said Agreement of January 11th, 1905 it was provided that if mining operations are suspended for more than six months the said agreement would thereby become mull and void.

And Whereas, it is desired to amend said agreement so as to provide how it may be kept in force from year to year at the option of the holder thereof, Now therefore,

this writting witnesseth: That in consideration of the premises and of the sum of Five dollars (\$5.) to us in hand paid receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we do hereby covenant and agree that the agreement now held by the said Company be and is hereby amended so that it may be kept in force and effect from year to year without the said Company being unded any Obligation to conduct, operations on the presmises described therein by the annual payment of the sum of Five dollars (\$5.) on or before the eleventh day of January of each year hereafter during the continuence of said agreement each payment of Five dollars keeping the said agreement in force for one year, beginning on the eleventh day of January the first payment receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, keeping the agreement in force until the eleventh day of January 1908, Such payments shall be considered as advancements of royalties and shall be charged as such to our account, but in no event shall we be required to refund any money thus paid.
