And Whereas, said Wm. 6. Sirrine has demanded possession of said lot, and said Adminic rator has refused to relinquish the same unless said Wm G. Sirrine pays to him the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars.

And Whereas said Wm. G. Sirrine has agreed to pay said sum upon condition that it be not considered as recoginizing my claim as existing in said administrator, default having been made by said J.E. Beneyfield in carrying out the terms of said contract; Now Therefore, this agreement witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars paid to J.R. Beneyfield, as Administrator as aforesaid, he does hereby release and relinquish all of the right, title and interest of said J.E. Beneyfield to the lot of land above refered to, and does hereby surrender the contract for title heretofore given to said J.E. Beneyfield and consents that the same be Cancelled.
