Whereas, Greenville Carolina Power Company, a corporation created under the laws of said State, did heretofore erect across Saluda River a dam thirty-nine (39) feet, more or less, in height above low water. And whereas said corporation proposes to raise said dam four (4) feet in height above the present dam as now maintained which addition will cause the back-water to cover a portion of the lands of the grantor situate in the County aforesaid:

Now, Therefore We, J.D. Willimon and C.L. Willimon of the County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to us in hand paid by Greenville Carolina Power Company, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have grented, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Greenville Carolina Power Company the right to erect and maintain the said addition to the said dam, provided, however that the same shall not exceed the height of four (4) feet above the dam now erected and maintained by said corporation and also the right to flood such portion of my lands as may be overflowed by said addition.

To have and to hold all and singular the said right and premises before mentioned unto Greenville Carolina Power Company, its successors and assigns.

And we do further release and discharge said Greenville. Carolina Power Company from all damages which may accrue to us, or to any one claiming under us by reason of the back-water caused by said addition to said dam.

And we hereby bound ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever, defend all and singular the rights herein granted unto the Greenville Carolina Power Company, its successors and assigns, against us and our heirs and all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
