(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

the said Thomas Q. Dower and his heirs and assigns forever

all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing
Twenty-three acres, and 27 $\frac{1}{4}$ poles, situated, lying and
being in Greenville County and State of South Carolina
on branches of Eocene River, adjoining lands of the estate
of Perry Newby deceased, Harry Poole, J. P. McElroy, and
others. Beginning at the stone 3 x 3 x one on road; thence N. 11
E. 18.70 chains to stone 3 x 3 x one, on old line; thence N. 80 $\frac{3}{4}$
W. 13.28 chains to stone 3 x 3 x one; thence N. 11 W. 13.00 chains to
stone 3 x 3 x one on road; thence S. 40 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 4.00 chains to stone
3 x 3 x one on said road; thence S. 62 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 5.00 chains to bend

person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
