State aforesaid, and known as the Northern half of Lot 4,  
Block 5, as per plan of land Royal addition to the City  
of Greenville S. C. and filed in R. M. L. office Books Z. Z.  
page 934, Beginning at and iron peg N. W. corner of lot  
4, Block 5, and a fifteen foot valley said Broadus  
Avenue; thence with said alley (South side) N. 76° E One  
Hundred and Fifty-seven (57) feet to a stake; thence S.  
15° E eighty-five (85) feet due three fourths (85 3/4) feet to a stake  
thence N. 76° E One hundred and fifty-six feet (56) to
