in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Dollars
Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
Carolina's Monazite Company.(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto
the said Carolina's Monazite Company

All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid
in Grove Township, being a portion of the homestead of the late James A. Moon, deceased, and conveyed
by John P. Moon to George P. Ashmore by deed dated December 16, 1892, recorded in R. M. C. Office
in Book "YY" Page 64, having the following metes and bounds, according to survey made by M. D.
Moore, July 31st, 1906, plat of which is hereto attached: Beginning at a stone corner on edge of
branch (stone missing) land of John D. Harris; thence S. 6° E. 56 links to stake in center of
branch; thence down the center of said branch 18 chs. to ^{the} at confluence of two branches; thence up
the center of the western branch 22 chs. to stake in center of branch; thence S. 31.42 W. 5.53 chs.
to stone 3x; thence S. 4° 51' E. 24.57 chs. to stone 3x in swamp; thence S. 71.2 W. 4.48 chs. to stone
3x; thence N. 21° 20' W. 39.84 chs to stone 3x; thence N. 68.37 E. 24.75 chs to the beginning corner,
and containing 60.56 acres more or less, bounded by lands of J. L. Rhodes, John D. Harris and others
Subject to right of way from the stone on branch on Cleveland line, ^{along and blue} to the Main road, leading by the
residence of the late J. A. Moon, deceased, to the Augusta Road, the purpose of said right of way
being for a good wagon road.

It is understood and agreed between the parties to this deed that George P. Ashmore is to receive
the rent of said place for the year 1906 and that he is to pay all taxes for said year. Said premises
are rented for the year 1906 to Wm. Tripp for 1250 pounds of lint cotton and this deed is made
subject to his possession for that period; any arrangements for Monazite Mining Operations, for
this year, must be made between the Company and the said Tripp.

TOGETHER will all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident
or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Carolina's Monazite
Company, its Successors ^{Heirs and Assigns forever}

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and
forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Carolina's Monazite Company,
its successors

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
