Shuman Attorney during the month of January 1906 for six hundred (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W.R. Gosnell, all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid and Oneal Township, containing sixty-three acres more or less, and bounded by lands of Eddie Hempley, J.H. Barton, Spart Bomar, William Fowler and others, and consisting originally of two tracts, one containing fifty acres, more or less, and being the same conveyed to me by Miley Floyd by deed bearing date the 4th day of January 1906, and recorded in the office of Mesne Conveyance for said County in Book R.R.R. page 467 and the other tract containing thirteen acres more or less, being the same conveyed to me by S.E. Noble by deed bearing date the 8th day of January 1906 and recorded in said office in Book R.R.R. page 419

TOGETHER will all and singular the Rights, Members, Heraditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said W.R. Gosnell, his Heirs and Assigns forever

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said W.R. Gosnell, his

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
