



1784. I have Admeasured and laid out unto Davis
M. Dowd a tract of 200 acres of land. Situate
Lying and Being in Ninety six District, on the
Waters of South fork of Saluda River. Below the
Indian Old Boundary, Bounding on the S. W. and N.
an Land granted to Ephraim Mitchell and on the
S. E. on lands lands granted to William Dickeson, all
Other sides on Vacant land, and hath such Shape
form and marks as the Annexed Plat Represents.




State of South Carolina Ninety six Dist.

On the East side of the Ancient Boundary Line
Pursuant to a warrant from John Tho.
mas Esq^r Commissioner of Locations on the north
side of Saluda River, Bearing date the 20th day
of July 1784, I have Admeasured & laid
out unto William Smith a Tract of land con-
taining two hundred and fifty acres, Lying
and Being on the North fork of Dutchmans
Creek. Bounded to the East by said W. Smith's
Land and Thorntons Land, to the north by
Abraham Morris Land, old lines of Isaac Pattons
Land Westwardly by old lines and Wm Ellers
Land, & to the south by the said W. Smiths
Land, and hath such other shape & marks
as the Annexed plat Represents.
