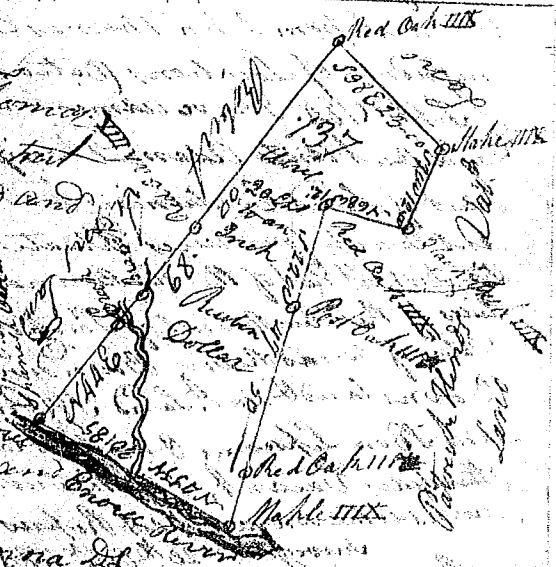


State of South Carolina

E. by Iron Pottery Swales Richd Howland Alfred Goodes Land NW & W on Neal Hamilton Daniel Oxburns and the Widow Harvey, and on all other sides on Old Land. That such White Cornmarks as the above plat represents Survey'd this 11th Oct. 1784 by Thomas Dodson Esq. Surveyor

E. on Robert Dolar NW & W on Patrick Dolar & N. W. by Enore River all other sides Vacant & that such White Cornmarks as the above plat represents Survey'd this 24th Oct. 1784 by Robert Thomas Esq. Surveyor
 Recorded this 12th January 1785

I have admeasured and laid out unto John Shep a Tract of Land containing 590 Acres Situated on 96th Street East of the old Boundary on the N. Side of Pacolet River. Boundaries S. on Pacolet River S. on Shep's Land all other sides Vacant & that such White Cornmarks as the above plat represents Survey'd this 19th Oct. 1784
 Recorded this 14th Jan'y 1785
