



Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq^r. Commissioner of Locations dated the 23 day of April 1785, I have admeasured and laid out unto Jacob Black a tract of land containing two hundred and thirty nine acres, situate in qth District, on a branch of Reedy River called the Reedy fork, above the ancient boundary line, bounded to on John Moody's land, all other sides on vacant land & hath such shape and Marks as the above plat Represents. Surveyd the 5th June 1785
Recorded the 10th Sept. 1785.




Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq^r. Commissioner of Locations, for Ninety six District No^r Side Saluda, I have admeasured and laid out unto Robert Gibson a tract of land containing one hundred and twenty one acres, situate on the south side of Pacolake River or a branch of Sandy Run, bounded N. 44° E. on lands belonging to Genl. Henderson, W. on John Haines land, all other sides on vacant land, and hath such shape and Marks as the above Plat Represents, Surveyd 23 Augt 1785, Jacob Black Surveyor.
