


South Carolina
 Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas, Com^r of locations dated 3rd Oct^r 1794, I have admeasured and laid out unto **Atthey Neeks** a tract of two hundred and seventy five acres of land in Greenville County on the branches of Mount Pleasant Creek waters of Saluda river bounded by lines running N. 75° E. on lands laid out for Atthey Neeks, by lines running N. 75° E. on lands laid out, and on all other sides by vacant lands, and hath such shape, form and marks as the above plat represents,

South Carolina, Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas, Com^r of loc^s dated 8th Sept^r 1798, I have measured & laid out unto **Nathaniel Walker** a tract of four hundred and eighty acres of land on both sides of Ward's Creek, and a small branch of Forked Creek waters of a fork of Sagg-er river, in Spartan-berg County, bounded by lines running S 55 E by land surveyed for a certain **Burns & unknown** N. E. & S. E. by an old survey called **Raywood's land** S. by **William Frances** land N. W. by **William D. Thomas** S. 22 E. by the ancient boundary line, and hath such form & marks as the above plat represents, certified the 15th 1798.
