

land on the waters of Johns Creek a branch of Enoe River in Mecklen-
County. Bounded by lines running S. & S.E. on George Kappens and
John Taylors land N.W. & N.E. on vacant & on Jepi Dodds and John
Gores Land, and hath such shape marks &c. as the above Recd Register
summed the 16th day of March 1792.
