30003 land N.E. and N.W. by Stevens land, S.W. by Henry Stevens and heirs of Thomas
Rowland, including several grants originally granted to different individuals and
also a small quantity of land heretofore vacant, and resurveyed for the purpose
of obtaining a new grant, having such form and market as the above plan
represents. Surveyed March 5. 1812.
