of Locations in the District of Greenville dated the fourteenth July 1842,

I have admeasured and laid out unto Joseph Edwards Jr a tract
of Land containing, Four hundred and ten acres situated in the said
District on the north and middle prongs or forks of Brushy creek
waters of Enoree River bounded by a line bounded by a line
running N. E. N.W. N.E. and N.W. by land surveyed for John
P. Shockley and John Howell c. N.W. and S.E. by land surveyed
for Vardry McVee, and William Cuspid N.C. and S.C. and
S.W. S.C. by land surveyed for Abraham Green, and hath
such form and marks as the above plot represents.
