SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Gertrude B. Agnew  
in and by my certain Promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

J.W. Norwood  
in the full and just sum of Three hundred  
Dollars, to be paid thirty days from date

with interest thereon from maturity eight per cent per annum to be  
computed and paid monthly in advance

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Gertrude B. Agnew  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said J.W. Norwood

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.W. Norwood, All that certain lot or parcel of land in  
the County And State aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, on the south side of  
McBee Boulevard, and being a part of the lands described in a deed from James T. Williams  
to grantor, which was subdivided into lots as per plat thereof recorded in office of  
R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book A., At pages 122-123, said plat being dated  
April 5, 1906 and being recorded June 30th, 1909; the lot being conveyed is No. 13,  
in Block A., on said plat: Beginning at a stake on the west side of Arlington Ave.,  
At the southeast corner of Lot No. 12, And running thence with Arlington Ave. S. 59.27  
W. 74 feet 1/2 inches to iron pin, northeast corner of lot #14; thence with line of  
lot #14, N. 31.44 W. 170 feet to iron pin; thence N. 59.27 E. 74 feet to iron pin At  
southwest corner of lot No. 12; thence Along line of lot #12, S. 30.40 E. 170 feet  
5 inches to the beginning. Being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Piedmont
