SEND GREETING:

in the full and just sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00)  
Dollars, to be paid One year after date hereof

with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of One hundred dollars  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (title which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the sum of One hundred dollars  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagor,  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said  
mortgagor  
in hand, well and truly paid by the said mortgagor

at and before the signing of these Presents, all receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said B. M. Wood, and his heirs and assigns,

all that certain piece parcel or tract of land with all the  
improvements thereon situate, lying and being in the State  
of South Carolina said County of Greenville in O'Neal  
Township, at or near Locust Fair Ground in the north  
side of the Old Buncombe Road on branch waters of  
Beaverdam Creek waters of South Tyger River, and  
having such metes lines and bounds as are shown  
in the deed made to me the said O. M. Southern by  
J. F. Loftis, which deed is dated Aug. 24th 1911, and  
recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County S.C.  
in Volume #17 of Deeds, at page 73, and containing 21 1/2  
acres more or less.
