WHEREAS, I, Louisa Noble

in the full and just sum of Two thousand two hundred fifty and no/100 (\$2,250.00)
Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$500.00 one year after date; \$1,750.00 two years after date;
with right to anticipate any or all payments

with interest thereon from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; and interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent (10%) besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind all of which is secured under this mortgage; and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.W. Norwood, his heirs and assigns, All that piece, parcel

or lot of land situate in Ward One, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina on the north side of Harvley Street, fronting on said Street 50
feet with a depth of 105.2 feet, known as lot No. 10 of a subdivision of W.M. Jordan
and P.H. & J.C. Cunningham as shown on plat recorded June 29, 1921 in plat book E., page
214, in office of R.H.C. for Greenville County.
Being the same lot conveyed to me this day by J.W. Norwood, Trustee, by deed not yet
recorded.
