with interest thereon from March 11, 1922 at the rate of ten per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid semi-monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. G. Hinkle

at a point on east sidewalk at intersection of Spring
and East North streets and running thence N. 69 E.
124.7 feet to pipe thence S. 20.17 W. 148.2 feet to pipe, thence
N. 69.42 W. 69.15 feet to pipe, thence N. 20.07 E. 43.2 feet
thence N. 69 W. 55.8 feet to iron pin in Spring Street
thence with Spring Street N. 21 E. 105 feet to the beginning
