with interest thereon from the 1st day of October 1922 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid on the note

and in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (and if such is secured under this mortgage), as well as and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. L. Pickler, his heirs and assigns;

All that certain piece, parcel lot or tract of land, lying in  
Greenville Township, near city limits of Greenville, State  
and County aforesaid, known and designated as lot no. 14  
on plat made by W. D. News, Engineer and recorded in office  
of Register of Mesne Conveyances for State and County aforesaid  
in Vol. "E" (Plat Book) at pages 251-2 and having the following  
metes and bounds; to wit:-

Beginning at an iron on the east side of North Street  
(formerly known as Spartanburg Road) corner of lot no. 15,  
of said plat, and running thence with line of lot no. 15 S.  
48-32 E. 194 ft. to an iron pin; thence 5.39-42 W. 80 feet  
to an iron pin, corner of lot no. 13; above plat; thence with
