 still with said branch N. 5° 45' 60 chains to an iron
 rivet thence N. 33 1/2 W. 37. chains to a stone, thence S. 75
 W. 11° 75 chains to a chestnut oak, thence S. 32 W. 15
 chains to a stake, thence S. 35 W. 5° 10' thence to a stake
