promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any  
kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Baroline Lewis Websterin consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better  
securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note..... and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me  
in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the saidPeople's National Bankall that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Greenville, S.C.,  
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, more particularly described as follows to wit:

Lot # 8 of the sub-division lying between Conestee Ave. and Aberdeen Ave. and being a part of the nineteen acre tract  
of land conveyed to Harry W. Lewis by Janet, Carrie and  
James Berrie, by deed recorded in Vol. B.B.B - at page  
138 in the R. M. C. office for said County and State.

The lot hereby mortgaged has the following metes and  
bounds: Beginning at the southwestern corner of lot #7  
and running in an easterly direction 180 feet to an  
iron pin; thence in a southerly direction 65 feet to an  
iron pin on the northeast corner of lot no. 9; thence in  
a westerly direction along line of lot no. 9, 180 feet to  
Conestee Ave.; thence in a northerly direction along  
Conestee Ave. 65 feet to the beginning corner.
