 promised and agreed to pay ten per cent. of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note.....be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any
 kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I.....the said *Jessie Hawkins*

.....in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
 securing the payment hereof according to the terms of the said note.....and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me.....

.....in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
 released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Sallie A. Harris*

.....all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in.....
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

.....on the old Paris Mountain Road near the over-head
 bridge over the Southern Railway track, beginning at an
 iron pin on the old road and running
 thence with said road N. 18° 15' W. 105 feet to an iron pin at
 corner of lot 720. 127; thence with the line of said lot N. 128° feet 10 inches to an iron pin on a twelve-foot alley;
 thence with said alley S. 6° 30' W. 120 feet 3 inches to an iron
 pin at corner of lot 720. 131; thence with line of said lot
 N. 71° 1/4 E. 154 feet to the beginning corner known as lot
 720. 129 of the Hammatt lands, according to a survey made
 by Wm. G. Lee, July 3rd, 1903, and being the same
 conveyed to me by William G. Sizemore on the 26th day
 of February, 1906, recorded in Book 2. S. S. page 85.

Also all that other lot of land in Greenville Township,
 County and State aforesaid near the City of Greenville, on the
 Old Paris Mountain Road near the bridge over Southern
 Railway track, and described as follows: Beginning at
 an iron pin at the corner of lot 720. 133 on flat herein
 after referred to and running thence with said old
 Paris Mountain Road N. 18° 1/4 W. 91 feet 5 inches to an iron
 pin corner of lot 720. 129; thence S. 71° 1/4 E. 154 feet to an iron
 pin on a twelve-foot alley; thence S. 6° 30' E. 100 feet to an
 iron pin corner of lot 720. 133; thence with lot no. 133 N.
 71° 1/2 E. 175 feet to the beginning corner and known as lot
 720. 131 on the flat made by W. G. Lee July 3, 1903, of the
 Hammatt lands, recorded in the office of C. M. C. for Greenville
 County in Plat Book A page 423 and being the same
 lot conveyed to me by Piedmont Realty Company by deed
 dated December 2, 1918, recorded in Vol. 16, page 236.
