in hand well and truly paid by the said The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said The South Carolina National Bank

of Charleston, Columbia Branch: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, said tract of land being the same tract of land conveyed to my grantor by J. L. Stewart, recorded in Book X, page 298, 1919, 1890. Being in the County and State aforesaid, lying on waters Reedy River, in Fairview Township, and adjoining lands of J. M. Woods, R. L. Meares, Mrs. Cathie Stewart Peden and others:

Beginning at a Stake at Mrs. Cathie Peden pine in the Neddy Ferry Road, thence North road 9.25 to a stone in the road, thence S. 74 W. 13.67 to a pine 34; thence S. 80 1/2 W. 49.60 to a stone on J. M. Woods, thence S. 13 W. 26.20 to a stone 37 on R. L. Meares, thence East 15.00 to a stump; thence N. 35 E. 21.00 to a stake 34; thence N. 52 E. 10.00 to a pine 38; thence East 13.00 to a stone 34; thence N. 1/2 E. 2.33 to a stone 34; thence N. 64 1/4 E. 17.36 to the beginning corner, containing 110 acres, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to the mortgagor by M.
