Ashley at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Avery T. Ashley, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, in ward six of the City of Greenville, on the north side of Lucille Avenue, and designated as lot number twelve (12) of Block "B" on plat of Chapin Springs Land Company, recorded in Plat Book 6, page 41, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin corner on the north side of Lucille Avenue at corner of lot number four (4) and running thence with Lucille Avenue N 88 E 50 feet to an iron pin corner of lot number 11; thence with the lines of lots number 11 and 10 N 2 E 130 feet to iron pin point corner of lot number 7, 9 and 10; thence line of lot number 7 S 88 E 50 feet to iron pin in line of lot number 6; thence with a line of lots number 6, 5 and 4 S 2 E 130 feet to the beginning corner. This being the same land conveyed to J. B. Mock by W. G. Rando, by deed dated Dec. 22, 1921, and recorded in R. M. S. for Greenville County in Book 74, page 181, and the same conveyed to Avery T. Ashley by J. B. Mock on May 4, 1923 recorded in R. M. S. for Greenville County in Volume 82, page 61, and the same conveyed to me this day by Avery T. Ashley.
