at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by

these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W. B. Belue; all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mtn. Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about three miles west of Landrum South Carolina, and being known and designated as lot #4+5 as shown on survey and plat of the J. M. Belue, land, made by W. P. Morrow, surveyor March, the 10th 1925, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown said plat to wit, lot #4 beginning at a pin in the road and creek line at the corner of lots 3+5 and running thence along the line of lot #5 S. 40 degrees West, 18.30 to a stake in line of lands of late Mrs. J. M. Belue, thence N. 82 deg. West 22.00 to a stake, thence N. 53 deg. East 12.00 to old P.O.; thence N. 28 1/2 W. 6.59 to a stone thence N. 66 deg. E. 16.95 to a black oak, stump in line of lot #3 thence along the line of last mentioned lot S. 55. deg. E. 8.50 to a point in line of street; thence continuing a long line of lot #3 and along the creek as a line 9.00 to beginning corner and containing 37.55700 acres more or less, and being a part of the land owned by the late J.
