All that tract or parcel of land known as lot No. 2, beginning at a stake corner of lot No. 1 and Reid lands and running N. 45 E. 12.20 chs. to stake; thence S. 16 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 15 chs. to stake; thence S. 61.30 E. 6.70 chs. to stone; thence S. 71 E. 15.85 chs. to stake at the beginning corner. This tract of land containing 47 acres, more or less, and one dwelling house and barn with a farm road connecting it with the old Greenville Road. This property being bounded on the south by the Reid land, and being bounded on the west, north and east by lands of Rufus L. Stewart, Estate.
